Senior Ride Nashville (SRN) addresses the transportation barriers that older adults face in Davidson County by providing reliable, affordable, door through door transportation for our riders. Our drivers take SRN members wherever they need to go, connecting older adults to the community so they can maintain their health, quality of life, and social interactions.

Our most frequented destinations are medical appointments, followed by grocery stores, general shopping, and beauty and barber shops. Some other destinations our riders access through SRN include: work, classes, volunteer shifts, community centers, meals with friends, and so much more!

SRN Rider Eligibility Requirements

- Davidson County resident
- Age 60 or older
- Able to safely transfer in and out of a vehicle with limited assistance
- Have the cognitive capacity to safely use our program
- Reside in one of the following areas: West Nashville, Madison, Donelson, Old Hickory, Hermitage, and East Nashville*

*SRN is currently planning for expansion to reach more of Nashville's older adults.


Become a volunteer driver
